Output

After conducting the feasibility study, BøthOfUs dedicates approximately a week for research, crafting a strategic plan, and establishing Key Performance Indicators (KPIs) to attain set objectives. The resulting document, termed 'Feasibility Study for Revenue Generation & Internationalization,' is presented to partnered Catalyst during a virtual session with an opportunity for Q&A.

This comprehensive document, presented in slides or PDF format, outlines areas for improvement and proposes strategies for achieving desired outcomes. The focus areas encompass:

- Design enhancements (UX, UI)
- Programming enhancements (web, mobile)
- Business model refinement
- Internationalization strategies
- Partnership development
- Funding avenues
- Resource mobilization strategies
- Establishment of a self-sustainable economic model
- Localizing strategies for Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs)
- Skill development initiatives
- Capacity building endeavors

Phase 1 primarily serves as the evaluation phase, providing BøthOfUs and the participating Catalyst an opportunity to decide on proceeding to Phase 2 collaboratively, focusing on implementing the identified KPIs.

This phase outlines the budget necessary to achieve desired outcomes within the industry. It can either be treated as an independent work package if the
